THE F.A.F.C. SATURDAY MORNING DEVOTIONAL
MORNING MANNA: LET THE WATERS FLOW WITH MIRACLES IN THE MOTION

TEXT: John 7:38 (NIV), “Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them.”

Water is one of the most profound symbols in the Bible, representing life, cleansing, renewal, and the Spirit of God. From the very beginning, the Spirit hovered over the waters (Genesis 1:2), signaling divine potential and creative power. Throughout Scripture, water becomes the medium through which God reveals His glory and performs miracles.

When Moses stretched out his hand, the Red Sea parted (Exodus 14:21). When Elijah struck the Jordan, the waters divided (2 Kings 2:8). When Jesus turned water into wine (John 2:1–11), He transformed the ordinary into the extraordinary. Each miracle began with obedience and surrender, an invitation for God’s flow to take control.

“For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour my Spirit upon your descendants, and my blessing on your offspring.” Isaiah 44:3.

Water flows where it is allowed. It does not force its way; it responds to openness. Likewise, the Spirit of God moves freely in surrendered hearts. When we release our grip, relinquish control, and allow the full current of God’s will to move through us, miracles are not only possible, but they are also inevitable.

“They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream... It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit.” Jeremiah 17:8

A life rooted in God’s flow is resilient, fruitful, and at peace. Even in seasons of drought, the soul remains nourished. The miracle is not always dramatic; it may be the quiet strength to endure, the grace to forgive, or the wisdom to lead. But it is miraculous, nonetheless.

Lord, we come thirsty. We come dry. We come ready. Let Your living water flow through every barren place in our lives. Wash away fear, doubt, and control. Let Your Spirit move freely in us, and may we become vessels of Your miraculous power. We surrender to the flow. Amen.

1. Water Represents the Presence and Power of God

From Genesis to Revelation, water is a divine symbol, used to cleanse, renew, and reveal God's glory. It is the medium through which His Spirit moves and miracles manifest.

"The Spirit of God was hovering over the waters." Genesis 1:2

2. Miracles Begin with Surrender

Every biblical water miracle, whether the parting of seas or the transformation of wine, required human obedience and divine flow. When we release control, we make room for supernatural intervention.

"Fill the jars with water... and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine."
John 2:7-9

3. God's Flow Nourishes Even in Drought

A life rooted in God's Spirit remains fruitful, even in dry seasons. His flow sustains, strengthens, and multiplies what we entrust to Him.

"They will be like a tree planted by the water... never failing to bear fruit." Jeremiah 17:8

4. The Flow of God Is Not Passive, It's Transformative

Water doesn't just refresh, it reshapes landscapes. Likewise, the Spirit of God reorders priorities, heals wounds, and empowers purpose when allowed to move freely.

"I will pour water on the thirsty land... I will pour my Spirit upon your descendants." Isaiah 44:3

We are not reservoirs, we are rivers. When we allow God's Spirit to flow through us, we become conduits of healing, hope, and holiness for our communities.

"Rivers of living water will flow from within them." John 7:38

Conclusion: Water in Scripture is never stagnant; it moves, it cleanses, it divides seas, and quenches deserts. So too must our spiritual posture remain fluid, open, and surrendered to the divine current of God's will. When we allow the complete flow of God to take control, miracles are not anomalies; they are the natural outcome of divine movement. It moves through dry places, reshapes hardened terrain, and carries the weight of heaven into the heart of earth's circumstances. When we pray with expectancy and surrender, we release the flow of divine authority that can change the dynamics of anything: hearts, homes, ministries, and nations.

"The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." James 5:16 "Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." John 7:38

Let us be vessels of that flow. Let our lives, our leadership, and our prayers move with the rhythm of heaven unhindered, uncontained, and overflowing with the miraculous.

Food For Thought: Water in Scripture reveals God's presence, power, and promise. When we surrender to His flow, miracles unfold, seas part, hearts heal, and lives transform. Our prayer life, like water, must move freely, carrying divine authority into every situation. Let us be vessels of living water, releasing heaven's current to reshape the earth with grace and glory.
